

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF UNNAMED ROAD, LODERS

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along UNNAMED ROAD, LODERS between its junction with Yellow Lane and the entrance to Corfe Farm, a distance of approximately 710 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 02 April 2024 and can remain in force for up to 21 days.

This Notice is required for health and safety reasons due to a landslide.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
