- Call a community meeting during an emergency (if deemed necessary).
- Provide the focal point for the community response to an emergency.

## Activation and Call out

- Dial 999, ensure the emergency services are aware of the emergency and follow any advice given.
- Contact Loders Parish Council via the Parish Clerk and the Emergency Co-ordinators (see below – Emergency Contact Numbers)
- Use the suggested log sheet (**Section 10**) to record:
  - Any decisions you have made.
  - Who you spoke to and what you said.
- Contact other members of the community that need to be alerted:
  - Those specifically under threat.
  - Volunteers and key holders that may be needed.
  - Contact initially may be to inform them of the emergency or inform them of current Emergency Service advice regarding any action to be taken.
