LODERS NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN REFERENDUM MAY 5th 2016

Dear Loders Parish Resident

Our Loders Parish Neighbourhood Plan has now successfully completed its examination stage. The next and final stage will be a Referendum on May 5th when all residents will have the opportunity to vote to decide whether the plan is adopted.

What is the Neighbourhood Plan for?

Our Neighbourhood Plan aims to provide an important tool for parish residents to influence the future of the parish and what is built in the area in the period up to 2027. It was prepared over the last four years by a steering group of residents set up by Loders Parish Council and was open to any resident who was interested in helping prepare the plan. Villagers have been consulted at every stage.

What does the Neighbourhood Plan contain?

The vision, objectives and policies in the Loders Neighbourhood Plan are based on the results of the Parish Survey conducted in 2012 which had responses from 81% of village households. They focus on four main areas: Environment, Community, Housing, and Business.

These are summarised in the enclosed document which is an extract from the introduction to the plan.
